



## 2010 AFP West Florida Philanthropy Awards Categories & Criteria

### Outstanding Philanthropic Organization

This award recognizes a foundation or charitable organization whose grant programs, donations and charitable activities significantly enrich the community. The recipient provides visible leadership and incentive for others to pursue philanthropic activity that serves many segments of the community.

### Outstanding Charitable Corporation or Business

This award recognizes a corporation or business for its philanthropic impact in the community through direct and indirect support of charitable projects. Leaders of this entity must demonstrate a high level of community spirit and participation, motivating employees and colleagues to support charitable activity.

### Outstanding Philanthropist

This award recognizes an individual, or family, for exceptional generosity and civic responsibility demonstrated by significant financial contributions to charitable organizations join the community. The recipient's personal generosity and community leadership should motivate others to give and to become involved in philanthropy.

### Outstanding Volunteer Fund Raiser

This award recognizes a person who provides exceptional leadership in coordinating fund-raising projects or activities for a charitable organization or cause. The recipient must demonstrate outstanding leadership skills and the ability to motivate fund-raising volunteers. By giving generously of his/her time and talents, this person makes a measurable impact on community philanthropy.

### Outstanding Philanthropic Legacy

This award recognizes exemplary philanthropic contributions made in legacy form via a bequest, trust, or other planned gift. To be eligible to receive this award, the legacy donor must have made an irrevocable gift where the proceeds have been received by a charitable organization. The receiving charity should document both receipt and use of this legacy gift. Members of the recipient's family will be invited to accept the award on behalf of the donor.

### Outstanding Youth in Philanthropy

This award recognizes service by an individual or group of young people ages 21 and under who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to the community through direct financial support, development of charitable programs, volunteering and leadership in philanthropy. Your nomination should include documentation of the long-term impact and reproducibility of the project or program involved.

Nominations must be typed or printed and include the completed 2010 Nomination Form. Nomination text is limited to no more than three (3) typed pages. Support materials and endorsements may be added as desired.

**Deadline:** Nominations must be postmarked by Tuesday, December 7, 2010. PLEASE MAIL
